## **CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS FROM CZECH REPUBLIC**

***DATES OF THE EVENT: JULY 26<sup>TH</sup> – AUGUST 5<sup>TH</sup> 2010***

### **Description:**

Sailors on the CitizenShip is a training course, which was developed as a module for youth workers/trainers to help them to answer their questions concerning the active citizenship issues. We approach the idea of citizenship on different levels: locally within our local communities, nationally, on international and global level.

During Euro - African edition we would like to focus on sharing methods, tools and concepts of active participation of youth in local communities and public life in general. We want to compare and learn about ways in which youth work and youth policy is being organised and implemented in our countries and share good practives within youth work that deal with active participation and active citizenship.

### **Aim:**

Sailors on the Citizenship is a training course that aims to promote active participation, through training of youth leaders, youth workers and educators from Africa and from Europe. This project aims to create a pool of multipliers and common tools among the partners involved which aware local young people about the importance of the active participation with attention at strengthening Euro-African dialogue and importance of exchange and cooperation in the field of youth.

### **Objectives**

- **sharing different visions and understandings of citizenship and active participation,**
- **exchanging good practices of initiatives of young people involvement in Africa and in Europe,**
- **approaching different levels of citizenship (local – national – international - global),**
- **training and developing key competences for active participation (ability to speak up your own mind, critical thinking, entrepreneurship),**
  
- pointing out the connection between citizenship, responsibility for one's immediate environment and society and active participation,
- experiencing, discussing and sharing historical and recent understandings of citizenship and its implications for participation,
- rising awareness about young people's involvement in civic society,
- promoting participation of young people in societies.
- developing sustainable network among partner organizations and among practitioners from all countries involved,

**What you can expect to experience and learn in key words:** Theory and training of youth participation in public life through workshops, practice of this participation through study visit in local youth NGOs in Tanzania, understanding realities of youth work and youth information systems in 4 European and 4 African countries through presentations and exchange of good practice and going through an unique intercultural experience.



**Target group:**

- youth trainers/workers who are actively working with young people as a professional or on the voluntary basis
- multipliers – who have potential to use this experience further on
- participants that have an active attitude and are aged over 18 (preferably up to 35)
- participants that can share good practices of youth participation, youth work and know or are willing to learn more about youth works and youth information systems in Czech Republic in order to be able to present it in a rich way
- Participants from the following partner countries: Germany, Estonia, Czech Republic, Poland, Kenya, Tanzania, South Africa and Uganda (we expect 3 participants from all of the above mentioned countries)

Date: **July 26<sup>th</sup> (arrival day) – August 5<sup>th</sup> (departure day) 2010**

Venue: Dar el Salam, Tanzania

**DRAFT PROGRAMME:**

<b>day 1</b>	Getting to know each other, intro into the project, understanding of citizenship
<b>day 2</b>	Active citizenship on local level, methods of community involvement
<b>day 3</b>	Active citizenship on national level; Exchanging concepts of youth work and youth policies
<b>day 4</b>	European & African active citizenship – concepts, ideas, tools & methods Active citizenship on global level
<b>day 5</b>	Key competences for active participation – levels of participation, principles of participation,
<b>day 6</b>	Study visits to local youth initiative and community centres
<b>day 7</b>	Study visits, sum up discussions of good practices observed during study visits
<b>day 8</b>	Working on ideas for future cooperation, evaluation

**Financial aspect**

**For African participants:**

Accommodation and lodging covered by 100% by the Youth in Action programme.  
Travel expenses covered by the Youth in Action programme: maximum ticket price 700 eur.  
100% Visa, insurance and vaccination costs covered mediate acceptance of the country coordinate organisation.

**For European participants:**

Accommodation and lodging covered by 100% by the Youth in Action programme.  
70% Travel expenses reimbursed covered by the Youth in Action programme: maximum ticket price 700 eur.  
Visa, insurance and vaccination costs: Visa covered 100% / Insurance and Vaccination Costs not Covered  
Participation Fee: 20€

There is a possibility to stay longer after the event or come earlier – of course covering the extra stay on your own costs.
